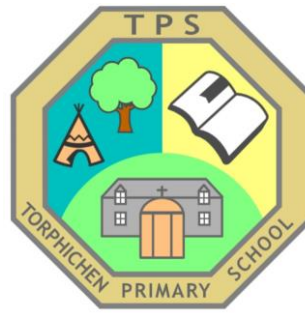

A Parent Council is a group of parents who represent all the parents and carers of children at the school.

Parent Councils can:

- Provide a voice for parents and carers in schools on issues that are important to them and their children
- Help the school to understand how to most effectively involve families in their children's learning and in the life of the school
- Support the school and headteacher in developing strong home/school partnerships
- Support the school in its development and improvement, and in understanding and making links with the wider community
- Capture the unique and varied skills, interests, knowledge and experience that parents can offer.
- Help to create an environment where parents and carers know that their views matter, and where they feel confident and comfortable putting them forward

Everyone benefits (children, parents, carers and teachers) when families and schools work effectively together to support learning.
