Previous large projects have included the Playground equipment and Library furniture but we also have paid for smaller items in the past and this term has also seen some resources for the garden purchased to support our school with their outdoor learning.

We will continue to raise funds towards the School and Nursery wish lists;

For the school the top of this list is the Projector screen and mount for the existing set up in the dining hall. Also on the wish list is some help towards outdoor resources and a new shed as the existing one is in disrepair after the recent storms. There is also some talk of an outdoor classroom area, sound like an exciting and very useful resource, watch this space.

For the nursery they are also following the outdoor theme with some help towards outdoor and garden resources as they build on their outdoor space and vegetable garden.
